## About Our Summer Trips

### Medical Treatment Release Form

Each participant attending a summer trip must have a Medical Treatment Release Form on file with the parish. Each form is good for a year and expire in August.

### Age Requirement

Each camp and trip has different age requirements. Each participant must make the minimum age requirement and be no older than the maximum age. When grade levels are specified use the grade the participant will be in the fall of 2012.

### Trips Fees

All trips have fee deadlines. Failure to follow a deadline jeopardizes the spot for the participant. Most sponsoring organization require non-refundable deposits along with registration fees that are paid in installments. If a spot in not fully paid sponsoring organizations will cancel that spot.

### Scholarships

Grand Horizons is a foundation that sponsors campers to attend DYMO Camp. This source is for those who have very little or no funds available for camp. They have an application to be filled out in addition to that of DYMO Camp's. If you are approved your entire camp fee will be paid. ### DYMO History

1972 First campers and staff attend Methodist Camp Lake Louise, Boyne Falls Michigan

1974 Format of Methodist Camp includes Catholic theology

1977 The Catholic and Methodist groups separate to allow the celebration of Eucharist during camp. Location moved to Camp Pinewood.

1985 A group of former directors unite to ensure DYMO Camp's future and give direction.

1986 DYMO Camp, Inc. incorporated as "not for profit organization", 501c3

1994 Endowment fund stated with a donation from "Fund for the Faith"

2002 Name change to DYMO Ministries, Inc., with the addition of other opportunities to support parish youth ministry programs. Additional programs include helping parishes provide retreats for youth and sponsoring Youth Leader, a leadership conference.

First Camp Committee was formed to move the responsibility of planning DYMO Camp from the Board of Directors to a volunteer committee selected by the Camp Directors
